WHAT ARE LEARNING DISPOSITIONS?

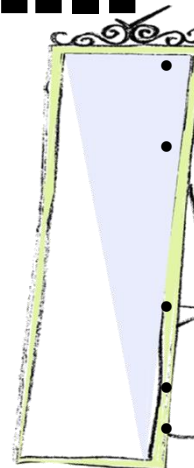
Learning Dispositions are frequent and voluntary habits of thinking and doing. A disposition is the way we would naturally respond to a situation. They are environmentally sensitive, meaning they are acquired, supported or weakened by interactive experiences in an environment with significant adults and peers. Disposition influence learning, therefore as teachers we need to be developing the dispositions to keep on learning, be ready and able to learn, to engage in learning and creative problem solving. Students at Risdon Park are able to Name, Describe, Apply and Internalise the dispositions. At Risdon Park Primary School, we have two main dispositions that teachers value and develop: **Bravery** and **Ownership**.

- Is resilient to tasks
- Takes on challenges
- Sees errors as an opportunity to learn something new
- Collaborates with others
- Seeks challenge
- Persists in learning tasks
- Takes risks



- Can self-manage and regulate learning and behaviour
- Refocuses on own learning without disrupting others
- Is organised for learning – has or knows where to find the tools required to be successful in learning
- Knowledge of strong vs weak choices
- Questions
- Seeks information/ new learning opportunities
- Supports peers
